#### GROUNDS FOR TERMINATION

The parties herein may terminate the whole or any part of the Contract in accordance with the provisions of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9184 – Annex "I", specifically No. III, Paragraphs A, B, C, D and E thereof.

#### VENUE OF ACTION

Venue of all actions arising from this Agreement shall be brought exclusively to the jurisdiction of the appropriate Court of Maasin City, Southern Leyte, Philippines.

#### SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

If any dispute or difference of any kind whatsoever shall arise between the parties in connection with the implementation of the contract, the parties shall make every effort to resolve amicably such dispute or difference by mutual consultation.

Any and all disputes arising from the implementation of this contract shall be submitted to arbitration in the Philippines according to the provisions of R.A. 876, otherwise known as the "Arbitration Law" and R.A. 9285, otherwise known as the "Alternative Dispute Resolution Act of 2004": Provided, however, that disputes that are within the competence of the Construction Industry Arbitration Commission to resolve shall be referred thereto. Provided, further, that by mutual agreement, the parties may agree in writing to resort to other alternative modes of dispute resolution.

BAC RESOLUTION DECLARING SHIFT TECH TRADING INC. INELIGIBLE AND DECLARING THE SECOND LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID (LCRB) AS A RESULT OF POST-QUALIFICATION, AND RECOMMENDING THE AWARD FOR THE "REBIDDING – SUPPLY & DELIVERY OF ICT EQUIPMENT & OTHER PERIPHERALS" - LOT 1

## RESOLUTION NO. 21, s. 2024

**WHEREAS**, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) was created to ensure transparency in the procurement process and in the implementation of procurement contracts, with the end view of guaranteeing the contracts are awarded pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, and that all procurement are conducted strictly according to specifications;

WHEREAS, in accordance with pertinent provisions of RA 9184, the BAC published on 13 November 2024 in the PhilGEPS, SLSU website and BAC Bulletin board the Invitation to Bid (ITB) for the "Rebidding - Supply & Delivery of ICT Equipment & Other Peripherals" consisting of 2 lots (LOT #1 & LOT #2) under Project No. PB2024-G&S-03 with a total Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) amounting to Two Million Four Hundred Sixteen Thousand Pesos only (₱2,416,000.00);

**WHEREAS**, in furtherance with the provisions of the Revised RA 9184, representatives from the Commission on Audit (COA) as well as observers from private sector and non-government organization, were invited to observe and witness the conduct of the Pre-Bid Conference, Submission and Opening of bids, Evaluation of Bids, and Post-Qualification as scheduled;

**WHEREAS**, on **02 December 2024**, BAC passed Resolution No. 10, s. 2024 declaring the Shift Tech Trading Inc. with the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB);

WHEREAS, on **09 December 2024**, the BAC issued a Notice of Post Qualification indicating Shift Tech Trading Inc. as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB). However, upon submission of their newly renewed PhilGEPS Certificate on December 17, 2024, it was observed that the certificate was issued only on **December 17, 2024**, while the previous certificate expired on November 29, 2024, resulting in a gap from November 30 to December 16, 2024. This gap constitutes the absence of one required document, rendering them **ineligible**;

**WHEREAS**, the second in rank based on the eligibility of the technical and financial components is **Leyte Paperworld**, as their submitted documents, technical specifications, and financial proposal met all the required criteria and were found to be complete, valid and compliant during the post-qualification evaluation conducted by the BAC;



WHEREAS, upon careful examination, validation, and verification of all technical and financial proposals submitted by Leyte Paperworld, BAC found their bid offer to be compliant with all the legal, technical, and financial requirements, and declared them as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB) for LOT 1 with a Total Contract Amount of **P** 1,127,538.00.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, with the foregoing premises considered, the undersigned members of the Bids and Awards Committee hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:

- 1. To declare Shift Tech Trading Inc. ineligible due to the gap in validity of their PhilGEPS Certificate:
- 2. To declare the Leyte Paperworld with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid for LOT 1;
- 3. To recommend to the SLSU Board of Regents as the University's Head of Procuring Entity (HOPE) to award the contract to the abovementioned supplier.
