CONTRACT AGREEMENT

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
2. The following documents shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as part of this Agreement, viz.:

- i. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs);
 - i. Schedule of Requirements;
 - ii. Technical Specifications;
 - iii. General and Special Conditions of Contract; and
 - iv. Supplemental or Bid Bulletins, if any
- ii. Winning bidder's bid, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;

Bid form, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder's bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted (e.g., Bidder's response to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;

- iii. Performance Security;
- iv. Notice of Award of Contract; and the Bidder's conforme thereto; and
- v. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBDs. **Winning bidder agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.**

3. In consideration of the payments to be made by the Entity to the Supplier as hereinafter mentioned, the Supplier hereby covenants with the Entity to provide the goods and to remedy defects therein in conformity in all respects with the provisions of the Contract.
4. The Entity hereby covenants to pay the Supplier in consideration of the provision of the goods and services and the remedying of defects therein, the Contract Price or such other sum as may become payable under the provisions of the contract at the time and in the manner prescribed by the contract.

GROUND S FOR TERMINATION

The parties herein may terminate the whole or any part of the Contract in accordance with the provisions of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9184 – Annex "I", specifically No. III, Paragraphs A, B, C, D and E thereof.

VENUE OF ACTION

Venue of all actions arising from this Agreement shall be brought exclusively to the jurisdiction of the appropriate Court of Maasin City, Southern Leyte, Philippines.







BAC RESOLUTION DECLARING THE LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID (LCRB) AS A RESULT OF POST QUALIFICATION AND RECOMMENDING AWARD FOR THE "REBIDDING-PROCUREMENT OF VARIOUS OFFICE EQUIPMENT"

RESOLUTION NO. 06, s. 2025

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) was created to ensure transparency in the procurement process and in the implementation of procurement contracts, with the end view of guaranteeing the contracts are awarded pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, and that all procurement are conducted strictly according to specifications;

WHEREAS, in accordance with pertinent provisions of RA 9184, the BAC published on 15 April 2025 in the PhilGEPS, SLSU website and BAC Bulletin board the Invitation to Bid (ITB) for the "**Rebidding-Procurement of Various Office Equipment**" consisting of **9 items** under Project No. **PB2025-G&S-01** with a total Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) amounting to **One Million Fifty Eight Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-Eight Pesos only (₱1,058,398.00)**;

WHEREAS, in furtherance with the provisions of the Revised RA 9184, representatives from the Commission on Audit (COA) as well as observers from private sector and non-government organization, were invited to observe and witness the conduct of the Pre-Bid Conference, Submission and Opening of bids, Evaluation of Bids, and Post-Qualification as scheduled;

WHEREAS, on **05 May 2025**, BAC passed Resolution No. 03, s. 2025 declaring the Compuspec Sales & Services with the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB).

WHEREAS, the BAC initially identified Leyte Paperworld as the Lowest Calculated Bidder (LCB) for Item No. 2 – Portable Sound System, however, upon further evaluation and assessment, the BAC & findings of the Technical Working Group (TWG) was determined that Leyte Paperworld's bid was non-responsive and did not meet the required technical specifications set forth in the bidding documents, particularly in the specification for the Speaker Drivers. As such, Leyte Paperworld was post-disqualified in accordance with Section 34.6 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184. Moreover, **Item No. 6 – Network Switch** is to be awarded to **Leyte Paperworld** as the **Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB)**, with a Total Contract Amount of **₱ 97,776.00**;

WHEREAS, **Compuspec Sales & Services** was identified as the **Lowest Calculated Bidder (LCB)** for **Item Nos. 1, 3, 4, & 5**, and as the **next Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder (LCRB)** for **Item No. 2**. Upon careful examination, validation and verification of all technical and financial proposals submitted by **Compuspec Sales &**




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Services, BAC found their bids offer to be compliant with all the legal, technical and financial requirements, and declared as the **Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB)** for **Item Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, & 5**, with a Total Contract Amount of **₱ 898,940.00**.


NOW, THEREFORE, with the foregoing premises considered, the undersigned members of the Bids and Awards Committee hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to wit:

1. To declare Leyte Paperworld with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid for **Item No. 6**;
2. To declare Compuspec Sales & Services with the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid for **Item Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5**;


